You are welcome to Brazil, to Bahia and to Universidade Estadual do Sudoeste da Bahia - UESB!

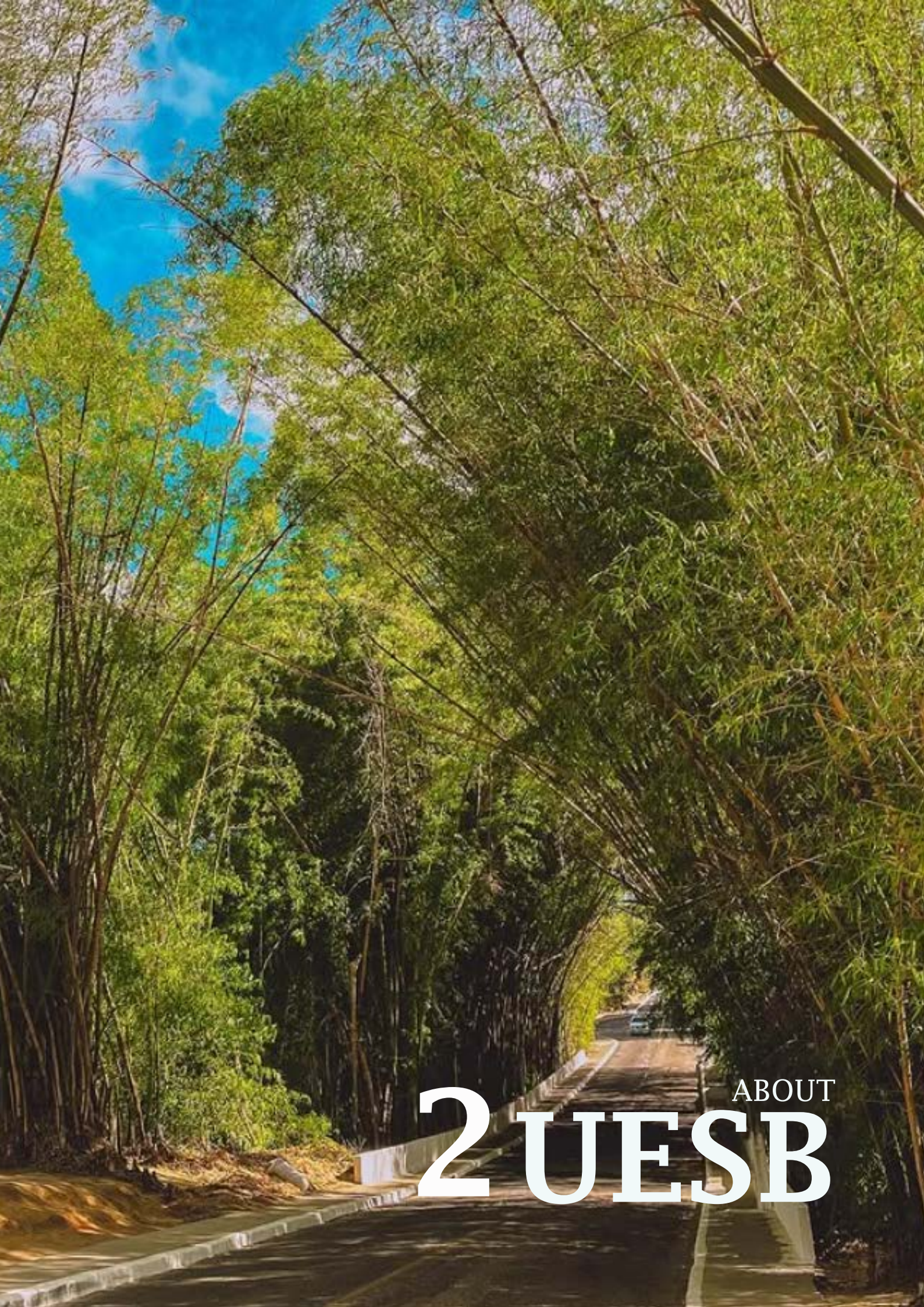
We hope that your period of study at our University will become an excellent opportunity for your learning, academic and sociocultural experience, contributing significantly to your personal, academic and professional development.

2 ABOUT UESB

Established on the 30th of December, 1980, Southwest Bahia State University (UESB) has been a reference in higher education in the interior regions of Bahia and northern Minas Gerais for the past four decades. Celebrating its 45th anniversary in 2025, UESB is recognized as a reference institution in undergraduate and graduate courses, as well as in the field of research, extension and scientific production of knowledge. The University's commitment to quality education is reflected in its broad diversity of courses and in its impact on regional, national and, in some areas, international development.

UESB offers more than three thousand admissions in undergraduate courses annually through 47 (forty-seven) courses, located on the campuses of Itapetinga, Jequié and Vitória da Conquista.

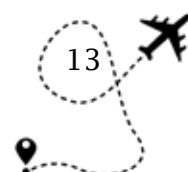
3 INTERNATIONAL OFFICE - ARInt

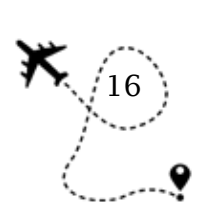


4 PLANNING YOUR ARRIVAL INTO BRAZIL AND UESB

4.1 TRAVEL ITINERARY from the country of origin to UESB

Recommended route considering the main aerial low to the city of Vitória da Conquista, State of Bahia, Brazil:

- It is recommended that you purchase airline tickets from the country of origin to Guarulhos International Airport, located in the State of São Paulo, Brazil.
- From Guarulhos International Airport - São Paulo, it is recommended to buy airline tickets to Glauber Rocha Airport, located in the city of Vitória da Conquista, State of Bahia, Brazil (approximately a 2 hours journey).
- Students heading to the cities of Jequié or Itapetinga will be advised to take the bus (from Vitória da Conquista to the respective cities) or institutional transport (when available).
- The distance from Vitória da Conquista to the city of Jequié is 155 (one hundred and fifty-five) kilometers, totaling approximately 3 hours of travel.
- The distance from Vitória da Conquista to the city of Itapetinga is 100 (one hundred) kilometers, totaling approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes of travel.



4.2 RECEPTION at Glauber Rocha Airport in Vitória da Conquista or at the Bus Terminals in the cities of Jequié, Itapetinga and Vitória da Conquista

The ARInt team and the Special Advisors of the Jequié and Itapetinga Campuses will welcome the foreign student and take him/her to the accommodation, previously arranged by the exchange student.

4.3 HEALTH INSURANCE

Health insurance is mandatory for all foreign students and must be arranged before traveling to Brazil. It is the responsibility of the foreign student to purchase the insurance, which is valid from the moment they leave their country of origin until they return to their home country. It must cover the following expenses:

- medical-hospital;
- repatriation - medical and funeral; accidental death;
- total or partial permanent disability resulting from an accident.

If the student arrives in Brazil without previously purchased health insurance, he/she must purchase insurance upon arrival at Uesb.

4.4 VISA



To enroll at UESB, it is compulsory to have a Student Visa or Mercosur Visa (for countries participating in the group), which can be obtained at the consular office of the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate in the student's country of origin;



Apply for the visa in advance in order to complete all bureaucratic procedures;



It is recommended to enter Brazil with a Student or Mercosur Visa to facilitate the other bureaucratic procedures required for the student to remain in the country;

4.5 INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYER REGISTRY - CPF

- The CPF is used by Brazilian and foreign citizens to open bank accounts, apply for a credit card, a Brazilian SIM card for cell phones with internet access, among other needs.
- The CPF can be requested, while still in the country of origin, together with the Visa.

Procedures for requesting a CPF:

- ✓ Fill out the online form available on the Brazilian Federal Revenue Service (Receita Federal) website (<https://www.gov.br/pt-br/servicos/obter-cartao-de-cpf>).
- ✓ Once this is done, the following documents must be sent to exterior@rfb.gov.br
 - Completed and signed application form;
 - Identification document (Valid passport);
 - Photograph showing an open identification document, close to the face;
 - Other documents that may be requested (check the guidelines on the indicated page).

If the student arrives in Brazil without a CPF, he/she can carry out the following procedures to obtain it:

- ✓ Before going to the Federal Revenue Office, the student must go to a Post Office (Correios) and pay a fee of R\$7.00 (seven reais) to carry out the initial procedure for requesting a CPF;
- ✓ Next, you need to schedule a date and time to go to the Federal Revenue Service to complete the CPF application;
- ✓ Once this is done, on the same day and time scheduled, the student will leave the Federal Revenue Office with the CPF number ready for use.

Important documents to apply for a CPF:

- Proof of payment of the fee;
- Service protocol with the Federal Police (Polícia Federal), regarding the CRNM (National Migration Registration Card);
- Valid passport;
- Other documents as requested by the Federal Revenue Service.

5 AFTER ARRIVAL INTO BRAZIL AND UESB

5.1 REGISTRATION

Undergraduate international students

ARInt, through the International Mobility Coordination, will organize the enrollment process and forward it to the specific Course Coordination, as well as to the Course Secretariats (Vitória da Conquista, Jequié or Itapetinga).

List of documents for enrollment - Undergraduate

- Copy of valid passport;
- Student Visa - Temporary residence;
- Health Insurance for the entire period of mobility;
- Certificate of physical and mental health;
- Citizenship document (identity card or equivalent);
- Application form for students in academic mobility;
- Letter of Acceptance issued by ARInt;
- School Transcript issued by the foreign institution;
- Selection notice published by the foreign institution (when applicable);
- Learning Agreement established between the institutions involved;
- Proof of residence;
- Air tickets (round trip).

Postgraduate International students

The enrollment of foreign students in Postgraduate courses (Masters and Doctorate) will be carried out and guided by the specific Board of each course.

On the previous website - from the Pro-Rectorate of Research, Postgraduate Studies and Innovation (PROPPI), there is a list of all Postgraduate Programs (Masters and Doctorate), as well as specific pages for each Program, which include an email address for contacting the Course Board.

5.2 NATIONAL MIGRATORY REGISTRATION CARD - CRNM

- ✓ Upon arrival into Brazil, the student must schedule and present themselves at the Federal Police to request the National Migration Registration Card - CRNM, valid for a period of 12 (twelve) months. To do so, the student must fill out the form provided in the link below and then schedule a date and time for the appointment.
- ✓ CRNM is a mandatory document for temporary residence in Brazil and should be obtained within a maximum period of 90 (ninety) days from the date of arrival into Brazil.
- ✓ The Federal Revenue Service has systematically required the CRNM request protocol for the release of the CPF.

The student will not pay the amount corresponding to the CRNM request if he/she presents the signed and dated Declaration of Economic Hardship.

Relevant information

- In the immigration section of the Federal Police website (www.pf.gov.br), access the list of documents required to apply for the CRNM;
- Fill out, save, print and sign the form available on the page;
- After completing and printing the electronic form, check if there is an appointment available at the Federal Police Department (DPF) Unit and select the date and time for the appointment. To do so, you will need to enter the request code printed in the header of the form;
- Go to the Federal Police Unit in the city of Vitória da Conquista at the Citizen Service Center (SAC), located at Shopping Boulevard (Av. Olívia Flores, 2500, Bairro Universitário, 45.028-610, Vitória da Conquista, Bahia) with all required documents;
- Upon arrival in Brazil, the student may contact the ARInt team (arint@uesb.edu.br) and request support in the process of filling out, scheduling and monitoring with the Federal Police and other spaces indicated in this Guide.
- The CRNM is valid for 12 months, which is why the student will need to make a new request 30 days before the expiration date.

5.3 BANK ACCOUNT

It is recommended to open a bank account at Banco do Brasil.

Documents required to open an account:

- a) CPF (Individual Taxpayer Registry);
- b) Rental contract (housing) or Declaration of the owner (land lord/lady) with notarized signature;
- c) Proof of enrollment with signature of the professional responsible for Course Coordination;
- d) Valid passport.

5.5 UNIVERSITY RESTAURANT

ARInt, in partnership with the Pro-Rectory of Affirmative Actions, Student Permanence and Assistance (PROAPA) and the Pro-Rectory of Research, Graduate Studies and Innovation (PROPPi), will guide the Graduate Programs and foreign students for registration and access to the University Restaurant.

As stipulated in Article 2, Sole Paragraph, of Consu Resolution No. 02/2025,

[...] eligible postgraduate students under the “Foreign Student Retention Support Program” will receive a partial meal subsidy covering up to two meals per day at the University Restaurants on the Itapetinga, Jequié, and Vitória da Conquista campuses. Beneficiaries are required to contribute R\$2.00 (two Brazilian reais) per meal (Bahia, 2025).

5.6 LIBRARIES

After completing enrollment, the student may request registration at the UESB libraries and make use of all the services offered.

5.9 ACCESS TO THE ELECTRONIC INFORMATION SYSTEM - SEI

The Electronic Information System (SEI) is a system for managing electronic archival processes and documents, adopted by the government of the State of Bahia in 2017. From that date onwards, the processing and the signing of documents produced by UESB are carried out in the system itself.

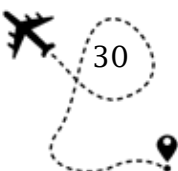

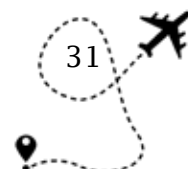

6.6 PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

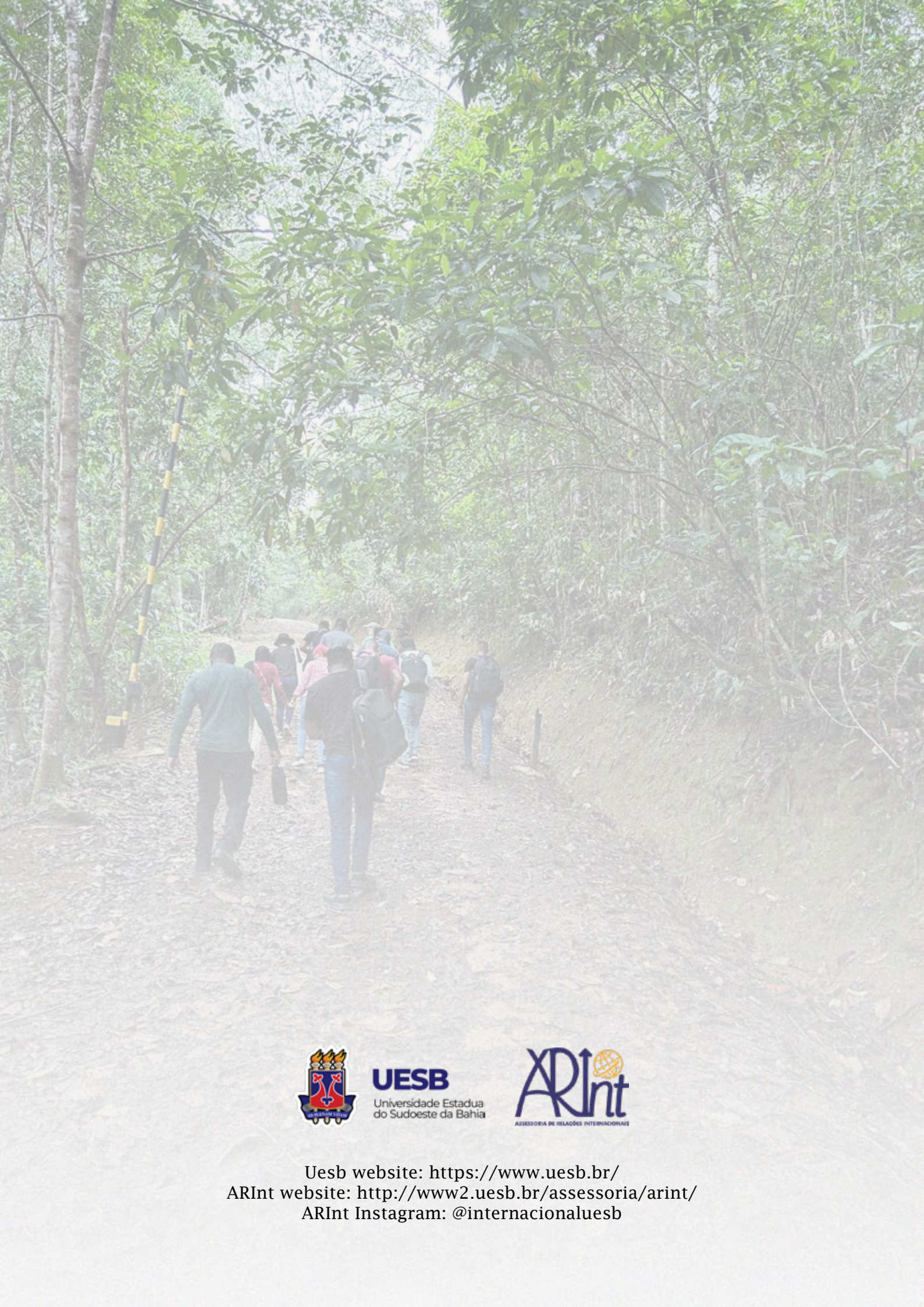
